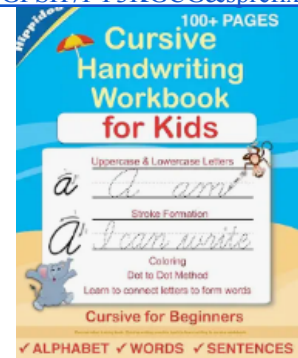
Craft/Marker Project Material
