Stationary:

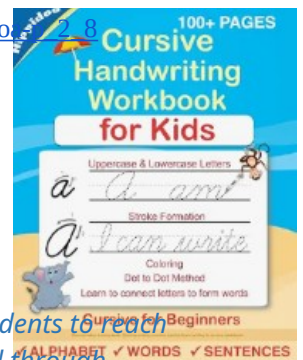
- 2 Packages Wide Ruled Notebook Paper
